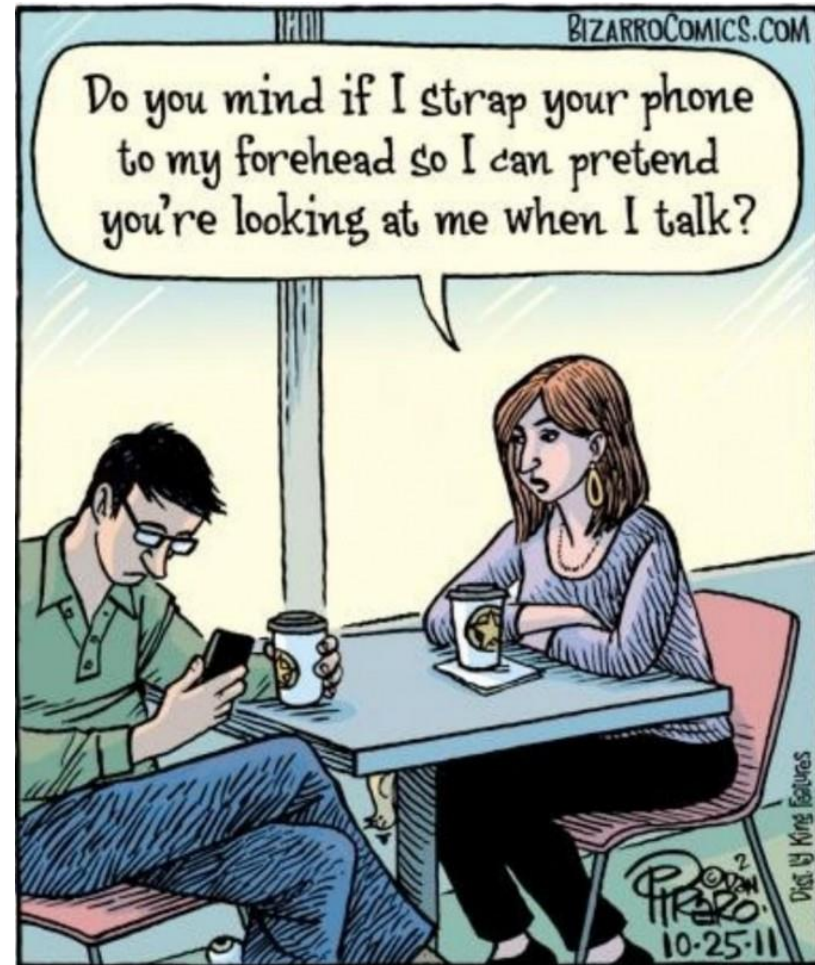

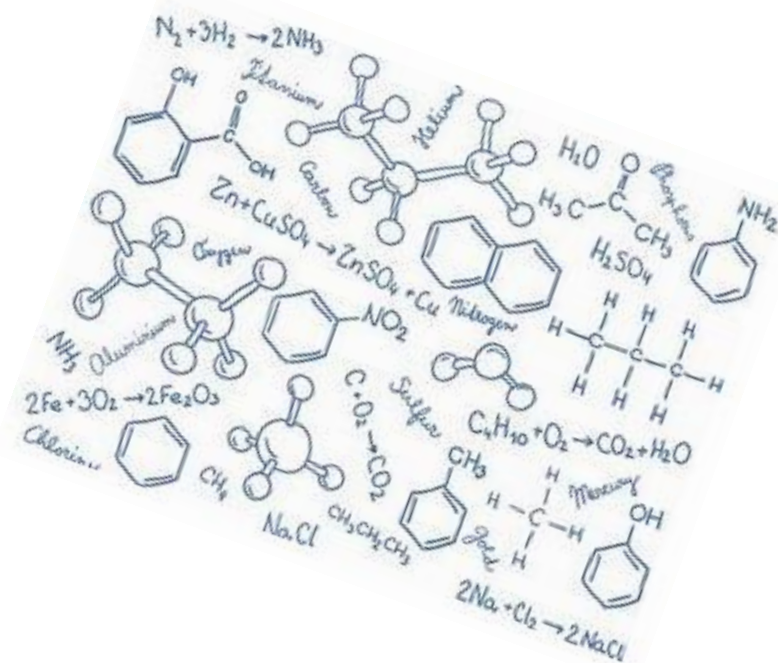
- 1 - Please provide to the YRFM Staff ID card, passport or driving license including a recent photo. The safety staff will check your identity during your registration.**

How to reach la Faculté de Pharmacie?



Aéroport de Roissy-Charles de Gaulle

From the terminal, follow the indications « Paris by Train », and find the RER B station. When you will be succesfull in this task, use RER B direction : Saint Remy Les Chevreuse – Robinson.

You will reach directly the station « Luxembourg » !

Approximative travel time : 45 mins.

Aéroport d'Orly

From the terminal follow the indications « Paris by Train - Orly VAL », and therefore you will reach shortly « Antony » station. Then, make an easy connexion RER B (Direction Mitry-Roissy Charles de Gaulle. You will reach directly the station « Luxembourg »!

Approximative travel time : 30 min.

The most economic way to join the conference venue is using Orly-Bus (Caution !! Depending on trafic, it might take a very long time !) which connect the airport to « Denfert-Rochereau » subway station; here you can use RER B (direction Mitry-Roissy Charles de Gaulle), You will reach directly the station « Luxembourg » !

Approximative travel time : from 1hr to several hours depending on typical trafic jams from Paris...

Paris – Beauvais

This airport (75 km from Paris) welcome many low-cost flights from Eastern Europe, Portugal, Spain, Italy, Ireland, Morocco. You will reach Paris using a bus-shuttle direction « Porte Maillot ». In Porte Maillot, you will find the subway station « Porte Maillot » nearby to the bus terminal. Then, use line 1 (yellow line), direction Château de Vincennes, and make a connexion in the station «Châtelet les Halles» with RER B (blue line), direction Saint Remy Les Chevreuse – Robinson. You will reach directly the station « Luxembourg »!

Approximative travel time : 2 hr.

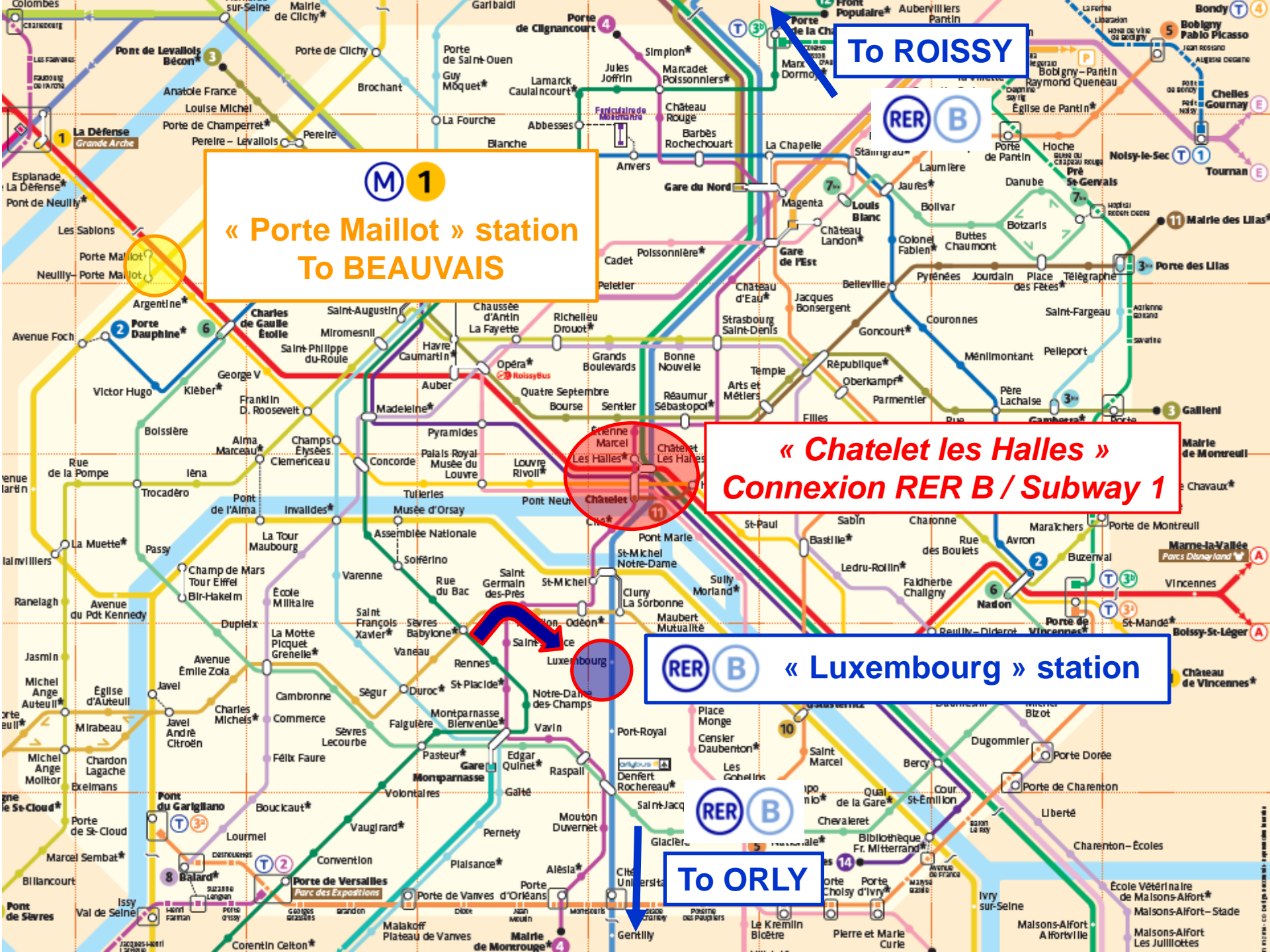

How to reach la Faculté de Pharmacie?

Gare de Lyon (TGV from Italy, Switzerland, Spain, Southern Germany)

You can use line 1 (yellow, direction la Défense), line 14 (dark pink, direction Saint Lazare) or RER A (red, direction Saint Germain en Laye - Poissy) and make a connexion in « Chatelet les Halles », and take RER B (blue line, direction Robinson – Saint Rémy les Chevreuse). You will reach the station « Luxembourg » !

Gare Montparnasse

From this station, you have two options : line 4 (purple), direction Mairie de Montrouge, and you will reach the station « Vavin », which is very close to the Faculty OR line 12 (green) direction Front Populaire and go to station « Notre Dame des Champs ».

Gare du Nord (TGV from Great-Britain, Belgium, The Netherlands, Germany)

Use RER B (direction Saint Remy Les Chervreuse/Robinson) and you will reach the station « Luxembourg »

Gare Saint-Lazare

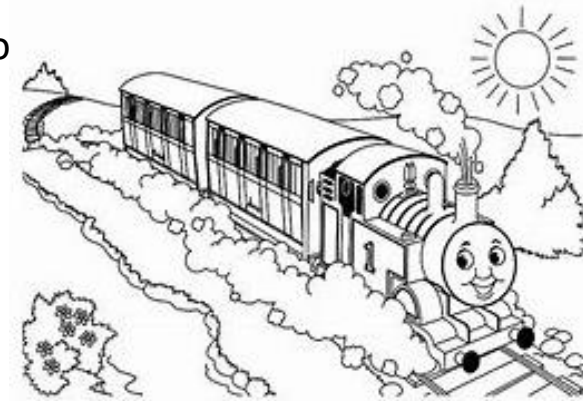
Use subway line 12 (green, direction Mairie d'Issy), you will reach the station « Notre-Dame des Champs », which is very close to the Faculty.

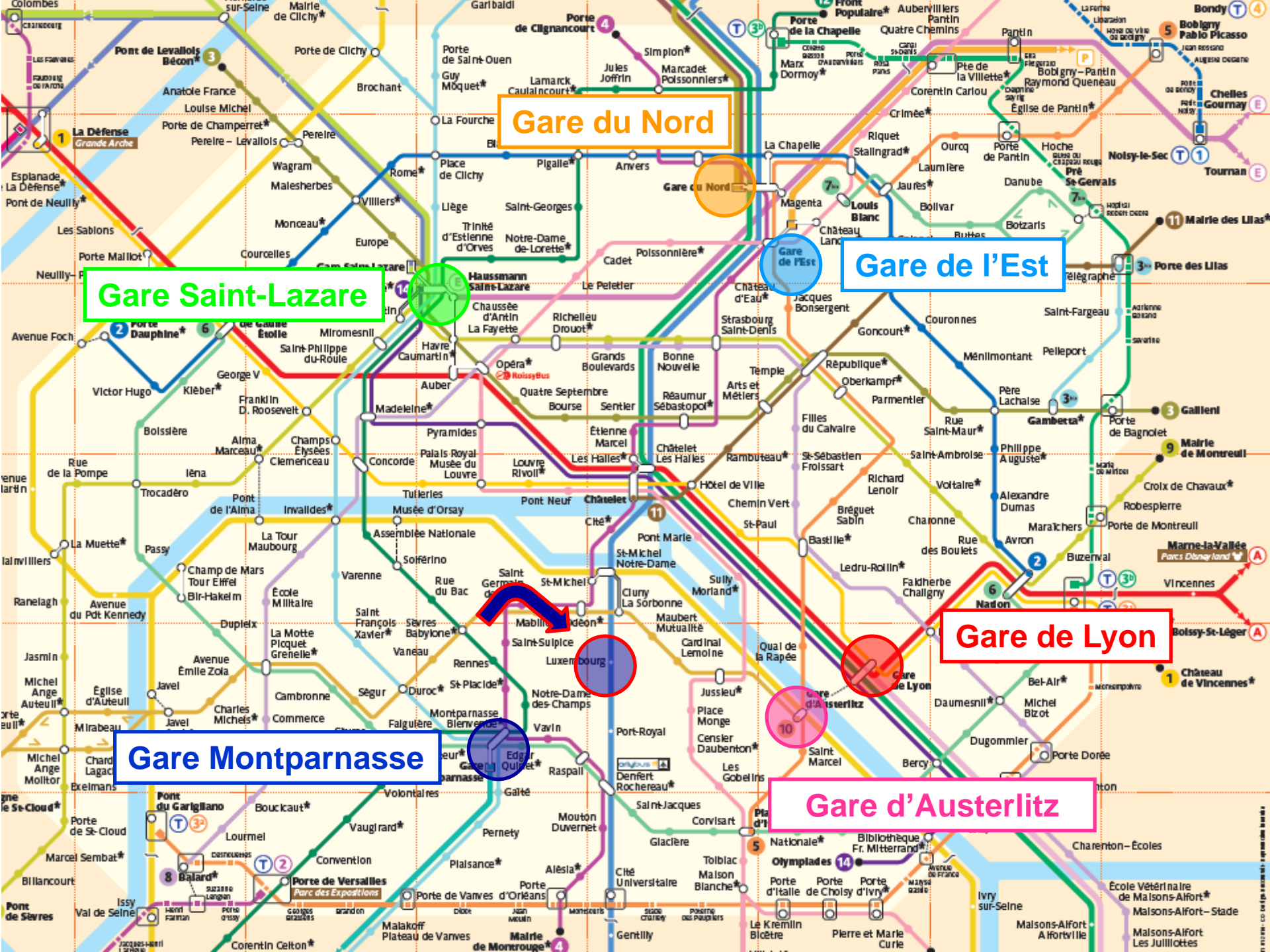
Gare de l'Est (TGV from Germany)

Use the subway line 4 (purple), you will reach the station « Vavin » close to the faculty. You can also make a connexion in Gare du Nord with RER B (direction Saint Remy Les Chevreuse/Robinson) and reach the station « Luxembourg »

Gare d'Austerlitz

Use the subway line 10 (dark yellow line), make a connexion in Saint Michel-Notre Dame with RER B (direction Saint Remy Les Chevreuse/Robinson) and reach the station « Luxembourg »

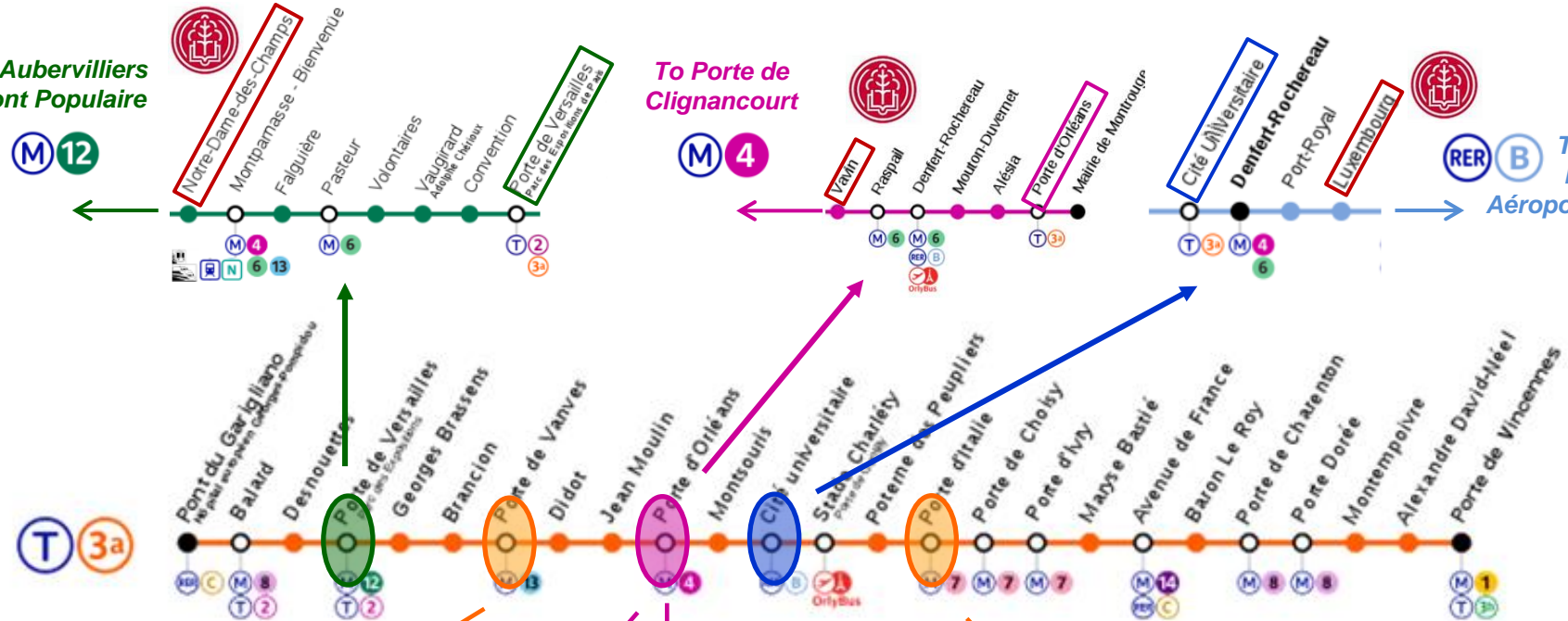

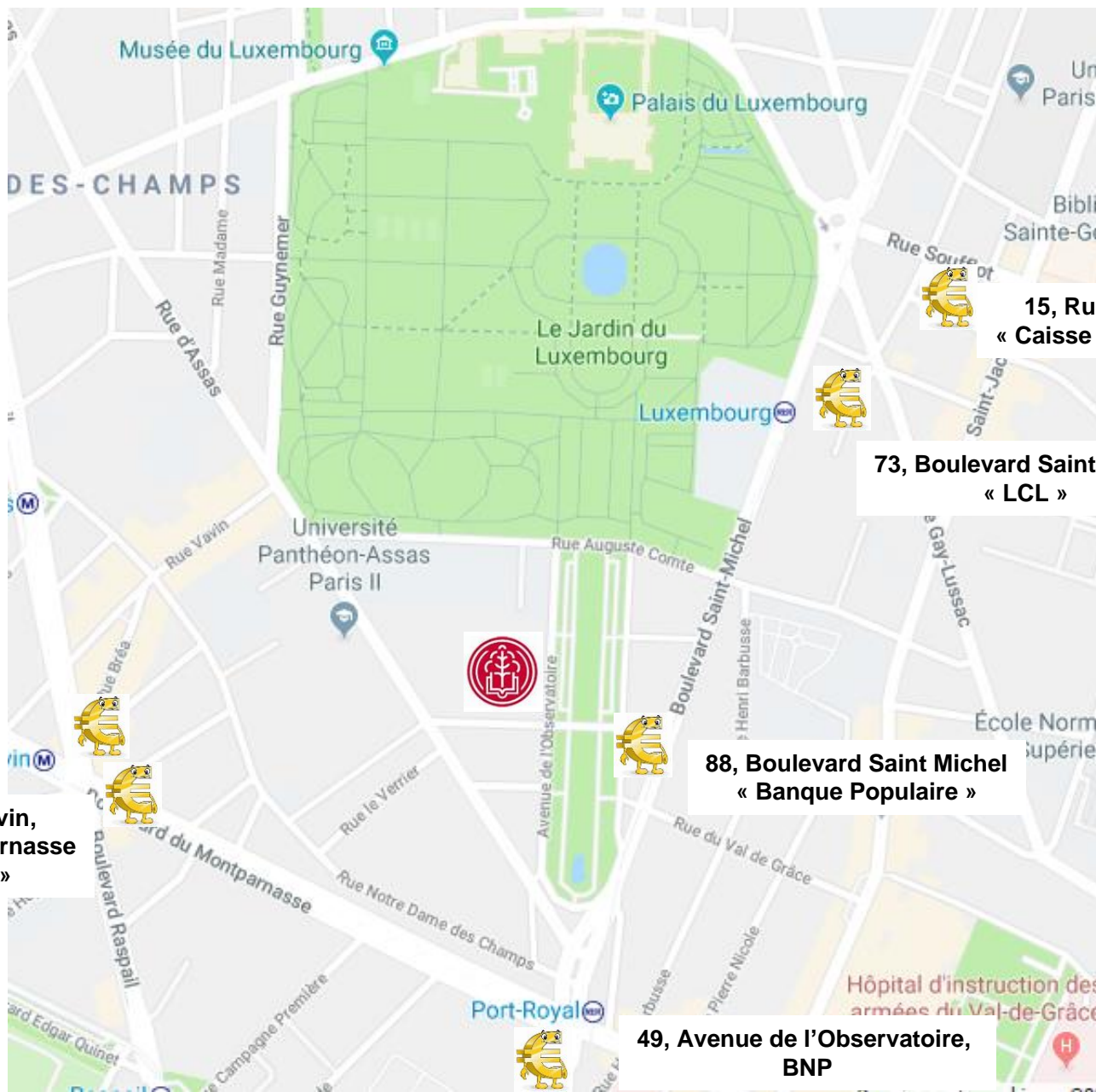

Selected infos for tourism !

Le Musée du Louvre – Mona Lisa and so many other Superstars

- Subway Line 1 and 7. Stop at : Palais Royal – Musée du Louvre
- Closed on Tuesday – Open 9:00 – 18:00
- Wednesday & Friday the museum is open till 21h45, you can visit quietly since very few people stay in the museum (some rooms close at 17h) !
- **ENTRANCE FREE (no fees any time)** for European below 26 y.o.

La Tour Eiffel

- Open 9:30 – 23:45 (lift access) / 9:30 – 18:30 (stair access)
- Subway Line 6 (station : Bir Hakeim) or RER C (Station : Champ de Mars)
- Book your ticket on the website to avoid queue (www.tou Eiffel.paris)
- Entrance fares depend on the floor you will reach...

Les Bateaux Mouches

- Several companies propose cruises on the Seine (Approx 1hr.)
- Prices : between 10 – 20 euros.
- Some starting points :
 - Vedettes du Pont Neuf, Subway Line 1 (Station : Cité)
 - Bateaux du Pont de l'Alma, Subway Line 9 (Station Alma-Marceau)
 - Bateaux Parisiens, departure from Tour Eiffel



Cathédrale Notre-Dame de Paris

- Open 7:45 – 18:45 (week) / 7:45 – 19:45 (Saturday, Sunday)
- Access : Subway Line 4 (station : Cité), but make a unique walk from Luxembourg through « Boulevard Saint-Michel », and across the historic area for students in Paris (« Le Quartier Latin »).
- **ENTRANCE FREE** in the church; Booking **MANDATORY** for visiting the Cathedral's towers (**No fees** for people below 26) on the website www.tours-notre-dame-de-paris.fr

Le Château de Versailles



- Open 9:00 – 18:30 (Monday closed) – Gardens : 7:00 – 20:30
- Access : RER C (Station Versailles Rive Gauche)
- **WARNING** ! Versailles is NOT Paris, check the validity of your train ticket !
- The entrance fees depend on the visit you want to do. For details visit the website : www.chateauversailles.fr



Les Grands Magasins

- Paris is also THE fashion capital for shopping !
- Most famous « Grand Magasins » are located near the town hall (subway 1 and 11 station Mairie de Paris), or on the « Grands Boulevards » near the Opéra Garnier (RER A, station Auber-Opera).
- You can also visit shops in the recently renewed « Forum des Halles » (subway stop : Châtelet) or in the « Galerie du Carroussel », which is connected to Palais du Louvre.
